We've had two **Inspire and Connect events** and both were a great success for meeting, chatting about opportunities and getting those creative juices flowing about what you can do here. From these events we listened to what and made a start on your ideas including **creating lessons** on the **beautiful wallpaper here, the garden, the menagerie, the people, the house and, specifically, the amazing and trailblazing Lady Mabel Smith**. We'll be creating and piloting more based on your suggestions so if you'd like to be involved in trying any of these out, all for free, drop me a line!

We also created **lots of visits** with you such as flower projects based on the Van Dyck room plasterwork, **emotional intelligence with the Grayson Perry** exhibition, the **social enterprise programme** leading to students' product soon to be sold in the shop with local organisation Labre's Hope, the beautiful **Camellia Quest trail** using art created by seven special schools with Artworks and many more photography, art, history and careers trips! As part of **work-related learning** we had 2 school work experience placements, 4 internship programmes, 2 Crankstart Scholarships, 3 apprenticeships, 1 T Level student, 4 Location Marshals, 1 university student consultancy project, 3 live modules and 1 traineeship programme. We also have lots of work placements in the gardens. We're looking to provide more of the same this academic year.
