Panelled Room

This wood-panelled room from the 18th century overlooks the West Front Gardens and features an impressive plastered ceiling and marble fireplace.

Low Drawing Room

This intimate space features a picture of Lady Anne Watson-Wentworth over the fireplace and offers views over the East Front Lawns towards the Rockingham Mausoleum.

The Library

The Large Library offers a wonderful studious environment, lined with Regency mahogany bookcases and two magnificent 18th century fireplaces by Fisher of York.

Thought to be part of the 17th century house, the Long Gallery offers a vast space for entertaining and glorious views of the West Front Gardens in any season.


